How did New Jersey shape the American Revolution and how did the Revolution shape New Jersey? Tea-For-All's talk on "COLONIAL TEA PARTIES: WHY TEA?" is one example. In it we discuss two NJ based Tea-party protests and other roles tea played in NJ Colonial history.

New Jersey is known as the Crossroads of the Revolution and for a good reason. More military conflicts occurred in New Jersey than any other colony during the American Revolution. But did you know that New Jersey was the heart of Smuggling and Privateering? And that tea was at the center of the smuggling enterprise?

Property, sovereignty and taxation: Today, the movement of people throughout the state, whether by car, train, bus, or waterway, is a staple of what it means to be a New Jerseyan! Historically situated between New York and Philadelphia, the state's history of transience, a crossroads of people coming and going, has shaped the very fabric of its culture. TEA was both legally and illegally transported along this corridor.
